Bid Request Summary 2017-05

Since the individual bids are expected to be less than \$50,000.00, a sealed bid process is not required. This is what is referred to as an informal bid process.

Selected and other bidders will be notified once a bid has been selected.

A separate **Payment and Performance Bond** is required for each project in an amount at least equal to 100 percent of its contract price. This bond as security for the faithful performance of the contract. This bond is required per ORC 153.54/ORC 307.89. Please refer to this law regarding bonds.

- If the bid is accepted, the bidder will enter into a proper contract in accordance with the bid, plans, details, and specifications. If the bidder fails to enter into the contract, Defiance County General Health District (DCGHD) may select the next lowest bidder. In that case, the original bidder and the surety bond are liable to DCGHD for the difference between the original bid and that of the next lowest bidder, or for a penal sum not to exceed ten per cent of the amount of the bond, whichever is less.
- If DCGHD instead resubmits the project for bids, the original bidder and the surety bond, are liable to DCGHD for a penal sum not to exceed ten per cent of the amount of the bid or the costs in connection with the resubmission of printing new contract documents, required advertising, and printing and mailing notices to prospective bidders, whichever is less.
- The bond shall Indemnify DCGHD from all damage suffered by failure to perform the contract according to its provisions and in accordance with the plans, details, and specifications therefor and to pay all lawful claims of subcontractors, material suppliers, and laborers for labor performed or material furnished in carrying forward, performing, or completing the contract; and agree and assent that this undertaking is for the benefit of any subcontractor, material supplier, or laborer having a just claim, as well as for the state and DCGHD.
