Drug Poisoning Emergency Department Visits and EMS Runs

This report was created as a surveillance effort to help understand the needs of Defiance County communities concerning drug poisonings. In the second quarter of 2022, there were 9 emergency medical service runs for drug poisonings and 27 drug-related emergency department visits.


ED Visits Broken Down by Sex


April: Male = 5, Female = 7

The emergency department data included in this report was gathered from the EpiCenter database for the date range April 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022.
