The board is looking at whether or not these reviews can be conducted in a combined way to make the most value of everyone's time.</p> <p>MVPO: Kim Informed the group of grant funding opportunities and facilitated discussion about an interactive website that Williams County is using. The website allows users to explore recreational areas in the county. Kim informed the group that MVPO is currently conducting a Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy update. Part of the update is for the community to complete the survey to help identify needs.</p> <p>Health Department: Brian updated the group on the Mental Health Wellness trail project. The HD presented to the Defiance County Commissioners and the DCGHD Board of Health.
