CHIP Dashboard Discussion	Hilary Kunesh, deputy director of New Home Development introduced what the New Home Development Company (NHDC) was and their mission. She provided an overview on their housing units within Williams, Fulton, Defiance, and Henry Counties. 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	<p>Hilary introduced NHDC's new project. They are in the process of purchasing a 16-acre lot which will consist of 10-units on 1-acre of land that are similar to Upton Heights.</p> <p>People living near these communities sometimes are worried/concerned about the people living in the New Home Development units.</p>	<p>Continue to think of ways to use the remaining 15-acres. The overall goal is to offer affordable housing. Some ideas were tiny homes, green spaces, dog parks, and regular parks.</p> <p>Raise awareness for the public to understand the purpose behind the units to attempt to break the barrier and address the concerns they have. Police Chief Todd Shafer stated they have very minimal issues within these communities.</p>
Dental Outreach	<p>Kim Limber provided an overview of what programs and services Health Partners of Western Ohio provided.</p> <p>Kim focused mainly on the dental care they provide, specifically to children in schools. They travel to all of Defiance County schools (Pre K- Grade 12) twice a year. They provide cleanings, sealants, and fluoride varnish to the children. The program is available to any child, even those without insurance. The child just has to have the parent sign a consent form.</p> <p>A question was asked if Defiance would be getting a bigger building, much like Bryan's building. The idea was suggested of building one or providing some office space for services on the 15-acres for the New Home Development Company.</p>	<p>Awareness/Promote programs</p> <p>Awareness/Promote programs</p> <p>Kim stated she was not in-charge of that, but had an idea of who could be contacted to give both suggestions to.</p>

Round Robin/Adjourn	<p>Doddie, MVPO: Informed group on the grant they were awarded for community housing impact program. They are looking for mobility planner to replace Kim.</p> <p>Tonie, Four County ADAMhs Board: Informed the group that they are constructing a data dashboard and they are waiting for the software. Partners will have access to dashboard, but public will not. Also updated that of those who do seek help for recovery, 52% are seen that day by a provider.</p> <p>Police Chief Todd Shafer: They have had an increase in bike and pedestrian crashes. The next traffic safety meeting is November 10th at 5:15 PM.</p> <p>Julie, FCFC: Working on early intervention for those born with developmental disabilities.</p> <p>Kim Limber, Health Partners of Western Ohio: Discussed that they were ordering more vans, it is a long process to get those.</p>	

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	<p>Stacy, Health Department: Informed group that even though department is down one nurse, still continuing with matter of balance program. One will be taking place at Kingsbury in December, and another will be occurring at the Defiance Senior Center in March.</p> <p>Hilary, New Home Development: Asked group if interested in joining housing committee to leave their name and email.</p> <p>Jack, Promedica: Discussed 2 classes offered each month. One is a childbirth class which incorporates safe sleep techniques. Another class called "Spinning Baby" prepares infant in better position, which lowers the chance of needing a C-section. The classes are free at the Women's Health Clinic at Promedica.</p>
